## Holbein Aqua Duo, or Royal Talens Cobra water-mixable oil paint in these colors will be provided for the

 workshop:The "core palette" of provided colors:

- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium Yellow (or Cadmium Yellow Pale or Light - not Cadmium Yellow Light "Hue")
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Sienna
- Titanium White

Water mixable thinner
Water mixable medium
Palette cups for thinner and medium


[^0]:    - Brushes - Synthetic bristle, long handle, for oil or oil \& acrylic (Princeton 6300 is a good series)

    Size numbers vary by manufacturer; go by inch measure

    - \#8 (3/4") flat, ideally two of these, for dark and light colors
    * \#6 (1/2") filbert, ideally two of these
    - \#4 ( $3 / 8$ ") flat, ideally, two of these
    - \#1 or \#2 round synthetic, ideally, two of these
    - Painting panel or canvas, and/or oil paper
    - Painting panel (e.g. "Gessobord" or canvas panel) or pre-stretched canvas, $8 \times 10$ " or $9 \times 12^{\prime \prime}$
    - And/or oil paper pad ("Arches Oil Paper", "Canson Canva-Paper", "Strathmore Canvas Paper Pad"), 9x12" pad Note: "canvas paper pads", not "canvas pads"
    - Painting knife or palette knife - Preferably painting knife with elongated diamond shape, round tip, roughly 2 " long
    - Brush holder or plastic food storage bag for carrying your brushes
    - Jar for water (peanut butter jars are a good size)
    - Sketchbook for initial sketch, \& pencil or markers
    - Palette or palette paper pad ( $9 \times 12$ " pad)
    - Cardboard box to carry your wet painting
    - Portable easel, pochade box or other way of holding up your painting while working
